I am writing on behalf of [REDACTED], DOB: [REDACTED]. Taylor has been seeing me weekly for counseling beginning on 10-08-2024.

[REDACTED] began seeing me shortly after he was involved in an altercation with family members that led to his arrest. Since that time, we have been working to address his anger issues. [REDACTED] has been very engaged in therapy, and he has been open about his challenges in controlling his anger over the years.

[REDACTED] described his life as "pretty much all conflict", and we have been working together on approaches to minimize this including anger management and mindfulness.

[REDACTED] has expressed a high level of remorse from his actions on the day in question, and he has been actively working to address this tendency. In my clinical opinion, his active participation in therapy, despite not having health insurance, speaks volumes towards his character and his desire to address these types of patterns in his life. He often expresses a determination not to repeat these patterns, and this comes across as genuine.

Clinically, despite his past assaultive charge, he poses a low risk for recidivism for this type of behavior so long as he continues to engage in weekly therapy.
